The following is an excerpt from the Barony of Vulcanfeldt Minor Carta dated April 11, 2022 describing awards and orders for the Barony of Vulcanfeldt

BARONIAL AWARDS AND ORDERS

- A) The Baronage holds the exclusive right to bestow the following Baronial Awards and Orders. Members of the populace are encouraged to give their recommendations for these Awards and Orders to the Baronage.
- a. Service Awards
 - i. **Award of the Alerion** is a first level service award.
 - ii. **The Order of the Eagle's Ascension** is a second level service award.
 - iii. **Poisson d'Or Award** is an award given to children under the age of 16 for service to the Barony.
 - b. Arts & Sciences Awards
 - i. **The Gilded Quill Award** is a first level Arts & Sciences award.
 - ii. **The Order of Vulcan's Flame** is a second level Arts & Sciences award.
 - iii. **The Ember of Vulcanfeldt** is an Arts & Sciences award given to children under the age of 16.
 - c. Other Baronial Awards
 - i. **Order of the Argent Owl** is annual award given to an individual who embodies the spirit of the SCA.
 - ii. **Radiance of Vulcanfeldt** is granted by the Baronage for gracious and chivalric behavior.
 - iii. **The Gilded Dragon** is a persona development award.
 - iv. **Period Encampment Award.**
 - v. **The Baronage Favors** are tokens or favors given out by the Baronage for personal service.
 - vi. **Honorary Citizen** is given to those who live outside the Baronial boundaries but have become an active valued member of the Barony.
- A) **The Order of the Sergeantry:** The following Orders have been created within the Barony of Vulcanfeldt to show that these members have attained these titles by passing a series of tests designed to demonstrate proficiency in a variety of skills and subject matters. These tests are administered by the Sergeantry of Vulcanfeldt. Acceptance into this Order is ultimately at the discretion of the Baronage of Vulcanfeldt. Individuals that successfully complete the requirements will swear fealty to the Baronage of Vulcanfeldt and have the right to wear the regalia of their achievement. If the member of the Sergeantry is not a resident of the Barony of Vulcanfeldt (Candidates do not need to be residents to apply), they are entered as an Honorary Citizen of Vulcanfeldt giving them the right to vote at Baronial Council Meetings.

- 1) The **Order of the Sergeantry** is divided into three categories:
 - a) **Sergeants-at-Arms** are tested in the Knightly arts and fighting skills focused on heavy weapons combat.
 - b) **Yeomen** are tested in Knightly arts and fighting skills focused on missile weapons.
 - c) **Gallants** are tested in Knightly arts and fighting skills focused on rapier combat.
 - 2) The **Order of Courtier** is divided into two categories:
 - a) **Artisans** are tested in the Courtly arts with a focus on excellence in Arts & Sciences.
 - b) **Stewards** are tested in the Courtly arts with a focus on excellence in service.
- B) **Champions of Vulcanfeldt** will be determined annually at the designated Champion's Tournament for the specific discipline. Each Champion will take an Oath of Fealty, swearing to defend the Barony of Vulcanfeldt, her lands, people, honor, and banner. During the term of service, each Champion will have the right to display the regalia presented to them. It is their duty to return this regalia the following year so that it may be presented to their successor. The Champion has the task of organizing the next Champion's Tournament the following year. All Champions must be current members of the SCA. A membership lapse may be grounds for dismissal by the Baronage and require the Champion to relinquish the title and regalia. The Champions of Vulcanfeldt include:
- 1) **Champion of Vulcanfeldt**: determined by a Heavy Weapons Champion's Tournament.
 - 2) **Rapier Champion of Vulcanfeldt**: determined by the Rapier Champion's Tournament.
 - 3) **Baronial Protector/Archery Champion of Vulcanfeldt**: determined by the Archery Champion's Tournament.
 - 4) **Thrown Weapons Champion** of Vulcanfeldt: determined by the Thrown Weapon's Champion's Tournament.
 - 5) **Arts and Science's Champion** of Vulcanfeldt: determined by the Arts and Science Champion's Tournament.
 - 6) **Bardic Champion of Vulcanfeldt**: determined by the Bardic Champion's Tournament.
 - 7) **Youth Armored Champion** of Vulcanfeldt: determined by the Youth Armored Champion's Tournament.
 - 8) **Junior Archery Champion** of Vulcanfeldt: determined by the Junior Archery Champion's Tournament.
 - 9) **Youth Rapier Champion** of Vulcanfeldt: determined by the Youth Rapier Champion's Tournament.

Office Descriptions

Seneschals are the legal representative for the branch. They are responsible for the coordination of the Society activities in their branch.

Exchequers are responsible for the handling of all SCA funds within their branch.

Heralds provide heraldic services to their branches including consultations, field heraldry, town cries, and court heraldry.

Marshals are responsible for making sure that all SCA combat and similar athletic activities are conducted in a manner that is safe and enjoyable for both the participants and the spectators.

Arts and Sciences officers are the local resource for arts & sciences in the branch. They may arrange classes, workshops, promote competitions, and hold monthly gatherings.

Chroniclers act as the secretary for the branch, attending monthly meetings, publishing meeting minutes and monthly newsletters.

Chamberlain ensures that the baronial items stored in the trailer and the storage unit are available when needed for events.

Lists manage contestant scores for heavy and rapier tournaments. Currently we host tournaments at Vulcanalia and Baroness War.

Landed Barons and Baronesses

A landed Baron and/or landed Baroness are the Crown's representative within a Barony and provide the inspirational leadership for a barony. They are empowered to hold courts, grant awards which are recognized in the Kingdom's Order of Precedence; and can have Sergeants, Yeomen, Gallants, Courtiers, and Lancers. Landed Barons and Baronesses are required to report to the Crown and their Royal Highnesses one month prior to each Coronation.

*Per Barony of Vulcanfeldt Minor Carta - Customary for the Barony of Vulcanfeldt 'for any votes to be taken, a quorum must exist that includes at least four of the Major Officers and/or the Baronage. Each person holding a Major Office may cast one vote. The Baronage together counts as one vote.'

"Major Officers shall be defined as those holding the offices required to function as a Barony: The Seneschal, Exchequer, Herald, Chronicler, Minister of Arts and Sciences, Master of Stables, Web Minister, and Chatelaine. While not a required position, Chief Scribe is also considered a Major Officer.

The Grandview Community Center is located at the front entrance to the Grandview Fairgrounds where we have held past Crown and Baronial events. We would be renting the Dining Room with a capacity of 108, the attached kitchen (not really for cooking but plenty of space for warming, prep and dish cleanup and the Multi-Purpose Room/Gym with a capacity of 250. It has easy access to Interstate 82 from both the east and west. Grandview classifies our event use as Non-profit and non-fundraising so the entire facility will cost us \$250.00. They do have tables and chairs for the dining room but not the multi-purpose room. There is plenty of parking in front of the building for easy access to the building.
