A Quick Look At The History Of Seed Beads

Confession; I am a textile arts enthusiast and a research nut. I have been doing quite a bit of poking around the research sources looking for anything connected to the use of mixed medium fabric decoration. What I mean is, the use of thread, paint, beads, etc.... to make raised decoration on fabric. That was the broader search. I have fallen down the rabbit hole with beads. Particularly glass seed beads.

Beads have been decoration for wearable items for at least 38,000 years. Some sources say 100,000 years. Beads have been made from everything from bone, shell, antler to clay, mud and ash, and everything in between. It was in the 13th century, in Italy, that the process for more uniform glass seed beads (tiny beads, hence the name 'seed') was developed. In Venice, glass makers were producing glass beads of all styles and around 1291, the Venetian glass makers relocated to the island of Murano to protect their processes and techniques.

The first seed beads were made one at a time. Very time consuming and inefficient. But in time, the technique for mass production was developed. It took two men pulling molten glass over a thin cane and letting the glass cool. Two men working quickly could stretch the glass up to 100 feet. After the glass had cooled and hardened, they then used a "guillotine" to cut the beads into the desired lengths, then the beads were then tumbled in a clay slurry to finish the edges and make sure they were smooth. This was the beginning of a process that has been refined into the process that produces the seed beads of today.

The Venetian bead business became a key trade item throughout Europe and in many other countries until the early 19th century when the Czech glass bead trade became a competitor in the market.

This is just a drop in the bucket as far as bead history goes, but it is key to my artistic endeavors. Now, I am off to connect the dots between seed beads and embroidery. Happy beading!

Office Descriptions

Seneschals are the legal representative for the branch. They are responsible for the coordination of the Society activities in their branch.

Exchequers are responsible for the handling of all SCA funds within their branch.

Heralds provide heraldic services to their branches including consultations, field heraldry, town cries, and court heraldry.

Marshals are responsible for making sure that all SCA combat and similar athletic activities are conducted in a manner that is safe and enjoyable for both the participants and the spectators.

Arts and Sciences officers are the local resource for arts & sciences in the branch. They may arrange classes, workshops, promote competitions, and hold monthly gatherings.

Chroniclers act as the secretary for the branch, attending monthly meetings, publishing meeting minutes and monthly newsletters.

Chamberlain ensures that the baronial items stored in the trailer and the storage unit are available when needed for events.

Lists manage contestant scores for heavy and rapier tournaments. Currently we host tournaments at Vulcanalia and Baroness War.

Landed Barons and Baronesses

A landed Baron and/or landed Baroness are the Crown's representative within a Barony and provide the inspirational leadership for a barony. They are empowered to hold courts, grant awards which are recognized in the Kingdom's Order of Precedence; and can have Sergeants, Yeomen, Gallants, Courtiers, and Lancers. Landed Barons and Baronesses are required to report to the Crown and their Royal Highnesses one month prior to each Coronation.
