Vulcanfeldt also has indoor fight practices/social gatherings occurring at the Grandview Community Center this winter. Watch Facebook for details.



Garb The Road Less Traveled HL Magdalyn Tynkere

I was at a pass for an article to write this month. I asked around and Her Excellency Dred Baroness Fiona Ingen Conchbair suggested I do an article on my own garb. Great idea! Most people try and place my persona by looking at my garb. But I ride the road less traveled.

There are some very loved standards that most SCA participants wear. The apron dress, sideless surcoat, chiton, doublets from all over Europe are familiar to the eye. Most of our Turkish/Ottoman populous wear the kalpak (felt hat), full skirted coats and knee boots. Beautiful examples of late period Turkish clothing in catchy colors. But what if an Ottoman persona is very early period? 1300? How do you garb? Colors? Fabrics? That is my road less traveled.

My persona is from the very early beginnings of the Ottoman era. Bursa, Anatolia. The year 1310. She is court adjacent, but not noble. So, the clothing is much more practical than the nobility, yet the colors and fabrics keep it in the same beautiful flavor of the richer women.

Layered tunics, long sleeve and short, paired with a long vest or hip length vest. Over wide legged pants, either tied ankle or untied ankle. A soft cloth hat. You can wrap a scarf around it, or just wear the cap or you can wear headwraps. Simple one scarf headwraps or multiple scarves in contrasting colors. Decorations, if you're feeling fancy, can include brooches, feathers, silk flowers (China, as early as 1000 bce), just to name a few things. These are my go to's. The research, just like all research done on a subject that was not very well documented, has taken years of love.

It is well known the women of the court were not seen by the public but that doesn't mean that the women outside of the court were sequestered and their fashion is recorded by status and area. I get asked if I am Persian, Mesopotamian, or Greek. The short answer is, yes, my garb is. As a woman of Anatolia, these are our neighbors and fashion influenced by all of them. So, I may have seen a pretty headwrap while I was in the market and emulated it. My long sleeve tunic may have a Greek design on the hem or I may have Persian beads on my vest. This is a perfectly acceptable to blend small bits of the surrounding cultures to make a rich tapestry for your persona to live in.

That is the short of the story. I hope everyone explores the possibilities that our trade routes offered and enjoy the little pizzaz of, possibly, Italian glass beads on your Elizabethan partlet. Happy garbing!

Office Descriptions

Seneschals are the legal representative for the branch. They are responsible for the coordination of the Society activities in their branch.

Exchequers are responsible for the handling of all SCA funds within their branch.

Heralds provide heraldic services to their branches including consultations, field heraldry, town cries, and court heraldry.

Marshals are responsible for making sure that all SCA combat and similar athletic activities are conducted in a manner that is safe and enjoyable for both the participants and the spectators.

Arts and Sciences officers are the local resource for arts & sciences in the branch. They may arrange classes, workshops, promote competitions, and hold monthly gatherings.

Chroniclers act as the secretary for the branch, attending monthly meetings, publishing meeting minutes and monthly newsletters.

Chamberlain ensures that the baronial items stored in the trailer and the storage unit are available when needed for events.

Lists manage contestant scores for heavy and rapier tournaments. Currently we host tournaments at Vulcanalia and Baroness War.

Landed Barons and Baronesses

A landed Baron and/or landed Baroness are the Crown's representative within a Barony and provide the inspirational leadership for a barony. They are empowered to hold courts, grant awards which are recognized in the Kingdom's Order of Precedence; and can have Sergeants, Yeomen, Gallants, Courtiers, and Lancers. Landed Barons and Baronesses are required to report to the Crown and their Royal Highnesses one month prior to each Coronation.
