Documentation requirements are in casual mode; Tell us about the thing you made; source references are encouraged, but not required.

*WORK IN PROGRESS: or one you rescued from the "Punishment Pile" and Finally Finished it! Like the SCA Cool category, you need to explain what you have going on with it, but super formal documentation is optional.

*YOUTH CATEGORY: (Under the age of 18) as an object/process/technique/science; please write something to explain it and tell us all about what happened with it. Is this something that you're super excited about? Did you learn a new thing you never tried before? Tell us! We want to hear.

*SOMETHING NEW: A new category, with a prize sponsored by Maestra Adrianna the Fierce; Either something you've made since the last Baroness War, or something you've never entered in any A&S before.

*DISPLAY ONLY: Do you have an item you do not want to present? You can do Display Only! Populace Votes for the winner.

*LARGESS SUPER SIX: Half a dozen Largess Items (multiples are great). Populace Votes for the winner.





Chivalry: Then and now

In our modern Middle Ages, to be chivalric is something we are encouraged to strive for. So... what is that, really? Where did the idea of chivalry come from?

The word chivalry is said to be the combination of the French words 'chival' (horse) and 'chivalier' (knight).

The Chivalric code started in the late 11th century as a code of morals among the mounted knights to set themselves above the 'common folk'. To show that they had social and moral scruples. Knights were sworn to uphold this set of morals in the name of king/queen and country. The were the basic tenets;

Martial prowess Courtesy Noble manners Generosity

Martial prowess is conduct on the field of battle. Having honed and sharpened skills to be able to defend the cause. Courtesy for your fellow knights and also those less fortunate. Noble manners to be used in court and out of court. Generosity in deed and manner as well as financial. These were the basic rules to be followed for the Chivalry daily because there were punishments for not embodying the ideal morals.

Later the church got involved in the chivalric ideal adding devotion to religion to the vows. It gave the church a foothold into the military strength by adding vows to protect the church and those in need to the vows to king and country.

Chivalry ideals changed frequently things added and taken away at the whim of the kings of the country in which the knights served.

By the 14th century, chivalry became romanticized with the telling of stories of bravery and kindness being shared in print and in spoken word. It has remained a romantic ideology through the centuries. During the jousting period, the Chivalry became a, shall we say, a members only club. Hence adding a family pedigree of nobility to the tenets. But luckily, that was only to be called a part of 'The chivalry". The tenets are something that everyone can practice.

Here we are in the modern era. Our idea of chivalry is a romantic one. Opening doors for each other. Carrying things for someone who has full hands. Using honorifics to show respect. Many of the social ideals we practice are hold overs from the original set of rules set in the 11th century. Courtesy, manners and generosity are taught to us from a very early age and shape our social skills.

In our modern Middle Ages in the SCA, chivalry is a cornerstone of our game. Because we encourage noble actions and courteous interactions, we as populous in a large organization, can visit other kingdoms and there is a basic common code of conduct. Like helping someone set up their camp, volunteering to help at events, a fighter making sure their opponent is comfortable without the sun in their eyes. Maybe not as in depth as the Middle Ages form of chivalry, but it works for us.

Office Descriptions

Seneschals are the legal representative for the branch. They are responsible for the coordination of the Society activities in their branch.

Exchequers are responsible for the handling of all SCA funds within their branch.

Heralds provide heraldic services to their branches including consultations, field heraldry, town cries, and court heraldry.

Marshals are responsible for making sure that all SCA combat and similar athletic activities are conducted in a manner that is safe and enjoyable for both the participants and the spectators.

Arts and Sciences officers are the local resource for arts & sciences in the branch. They may arrange classes, workshops, promote competitions, and hold monthly gatherings.

Chroniclers act as the secretary for the branch, attending monthly meetings, publishing meeting minutes and monthly newsletters.

Chamberlain ensures that the baronial items stored in the trailer and the storage unit are available when needed for events.

Lists manage contestant scores for heavy and rapier tournaments. Currently we host tournaments at Vulcanalia and Baroness War.

Landed Barons and Baronesses

A landed Baron and/or landed Baroness are the Crown's representative within a Barony and provide the inspirational leadership for a barony. They are empowered to hold courts, grant awards which are recognized in the Kingdom's Order of Precedence; and can have Sergeants, Yeomen, Gallants, Courtiers, and Lancers. Landed Barons and Baronesses are required to report to the Crown and their Royal Highnesses one month prior to each Coronation.
