The candidate Meet and Greet is Monday, April 21, 2025, 7 PM at RoundTable Pizza. If you have questions for the candidates please contact Rurik (Seneschal).

What went right, wrong, and what I'd do differently.

What went right: The Team! Communication! Site setup and tear-down. Castle setup and tear-down. The weather. We were blessed by the gods, mid 60's for most of the weekend, light wind, and few clouds. We locked up the gate at 2:45 PM as the last RV/merchant drove out and as the rain started.

What went wrong: I'm sure things probably went wrong or at least not as planned.

We did have an injury during one of the battles that required a trip to the hospital for evaluation.

What would I do differently...

As many know, I felt strongly about doing some things differently for this Baroness War. I tried them and they worked, but not well.

- Site tokens (have site tokens available at gate, people like to take home a site token as a reminder of the event)
- Gate copy (you do not need one for every person)
- Double check that electricity is turned on for the covered area (i.e. Baroness Tea)
- Better communication on points being announced in Court
- Day trips (for the bid, calculate that 1/3 of your attendees will day trip)
- Keep Sunday Prize tournaments
- Advertise, advertise, advertise (it's a fine line though between saturating social media and keeping the event in everyone's mind)
- Check trailer tabs for expiration dates.
- Prizes versus Points *Recommendation for the future from Her Ladyship Dana Chathair Saibhin A&S report: "one war point for the Barony with the most A&S entries (not the most winners) and a second war point for the Barony with the most Largess entries (again, not the contest winner). This would inspire more people to participate in A&S and Largess in support of their Baroness, hopefully without upsetting the marshal activities war points balance too much. And prizes could be given to contest winners."*

Section V) Baronial Council Meetings D) For any votes to be taken, a quorum must exist that includes at least four of the Major Officers and/or the Baronage. Each person holding a Major Office may cast one vote. The Baronage together counts as one vote.

Office Descriptions

Seneschals are the legal representative for the branch. They are responsible for the coordination of the Society activities in their branch.

Exchequers are responsible for the handling of all SCA funds within their branch.

Heralds provide heraldic services to their branches including consultations, field heraldry, town cries, and court heraldry.

Marshals are responsible for making sure that all SCA combat and similar athletic activities are conducted in a manner that is safe and enjoyable for both the participants and the spectators.

Arts and Sciences officers are the local resource for arts & sciences in the branch. They may arrange classes, workshops, promote competitions, and hold monthly gatherings.

Chroniclers act as the secretary for the branch, attending monthly meetings, publishing meeting minutes and monthly newsletters.

Chamberlain ensures that the baronial items stored in the trailer and the storage unit are available when needed for events.

Lists manage contestant scores for heavy and rapier tournaments. Currently we host tournaments at Vulcanalia and Baroness War.

Landed Barons and Baronesses

A landed Baron and/or landed Baroness are the Crown's representative within a Barony and provide the inspirational leadership for a barony. They are empowered to hold courts, grant awards which are recognized in the Kingdom's Order of Precedence; and can have Sergeants, Yeomen, Gallants, Courtiers, and Lancers. Landed Barons and Baronesses are required to report to the Crown and their Royal Highnesses one month prior to each Coronation.
